MASS ATTENDANCE DURING OCTOBER, 2017

Fr. Summers mentioned in a recent Sunday homily that the Diocese requires all parishes to count the people present at all its Sunday Masses each October. We are to count the individuals attending (i.e. the men, women, and children) rather than counting “families.” Fr. Summers thought you might be interested in what this year’s October counts were. Again, what this table indicates – by Mass-time and date – are the numbers of people at Mass. The counts were generally made at a point in the Mass when it was reasonably expected that all had arrived who were going to arrive. The counts, however, do not reflect the decrease the exodus of people from every Sunday Mass once the distribution of Holy Communion is underway.

◆ **BAPTISM** – Baptisms are regularly scheduled EXCEPT DURING LENT: (1) At the 11:30 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of each month. (2) At 12:30 p.m. on the third Sunday of each month and on the second Sunday of Easter. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in English) on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Red Room. Parents must register in advance of the class. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in Spanish) on the last Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. in the Blue Room.
