PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION: The USCCB has designated the weekend of June 27 and 28 for Peter's Pence Collection (a.k.a. *The Holy Father's Collection*). The funds provide emergency relief assistance to those who suffer from war, oppression, disease, and natural disaster and are distributed in the Name of the Holy Father.

DISPENSATION FROM BISHOP BRENNAN: All Catholics in the Diocese of Columbus are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass at least through September 13, 2020. If you are not feeling well, or have a fever, DO NOT COME to Mass. If you have risk factors for developing complications from COVID 19, DO NOT COME to Mass.

THE PASTOR IS DEAD. LONG LIVE THE PASTOR. Fr. Summers was asked by Bishop Brennan to become the new pastor of St. Agatha in Upper Arlington. Succeeding Fr. Summers here at St. Peter will be Fr. Chris Tuttle, who is currently a parochial vicar in the Portsmouth area. The move date for all priests changing places is Tuesday, July 14th. Fr. Summers intends to leave here after morning Mass on Monday, July 13th. Fr. Tuttle will move in the next day.

JUNE 21ST IS FATHER'S DAY. A blessing will be given them after the homily.

JUNE 29TH IS OUR PARISH'S PATRONAL FEAST DAY. There will be a Spanish Mass at 5:00 p.m. and an English Mass at 7:30 p.m. There can be no social-gathering festivities this year.

DURING THIS TIME OF EXTREME CHARITY, as Bishop Brennan calls it, please remember that St. Peter Parish was paying bills, maintaining the Church building and the McEwan Center, making the full payroll for our staff, and assisting our sponsored charities and organizations.

FOR VARIOUS REASONS, our offertory collections over the first months of our fiscal year, before the COVID-19 Crisis hit, have been considerably lower than last year by about \$50,000. Because of the Stay-at-Home orders due to COVID 19 there were no in-person Mass collections taken up for 10 weeks. The simple truth is that Easter is one of the most giving of seasons, with more sustaining donations than at any time other than Christmas. Thank you to everyone who sent in donations during the shutdown! Continuing in this time of lower income but increased need, we ask you to prayerfully consider maintaining or increasing your offerings and donations to St. Peter Church. You may continue to give through your Pathways envelopes or, even better, may join our Faith Direct online giving program. There is a link on the church website homepage if you would like to sign up for Faith Direct.

IF SENDING YOUR OFFERING BY MAIL please do not mail cash. When sending a check, please note in the memo line or include a message noting how you would like the funds allocated.

DIOCESAN STRATEGIC PLAN IN DEVELOPMENT. The Diocese of Columbus has been working on a strategic pastoral plan that addresses the shifting demographics and growing trends across the wide spectrum of Catholic life. Currently the focus is on two trends: (1) the severe drop in active priests in our diocese and (2) the significant decrease in Mass attendance among those who self-identify as Catholics. Regarding the latter, we are all aware of how few of our parish's registered members attend Mass weekly. What is happening at St. Peter is exactly what is happening in the Church at-large, both in the United States and abroad. As for active priests: in 2008 the Diocese of Columbus had 100 active priests; in 2019, we are down to 86 active priests, which includes 7 priests already over the retirement age who have needed to keep going. Many of our priests – 28 of them – will reach retirement age in the next five years. Soon, we will have only 65 active priests to serve our 23 counties and 108 parishes. Given these two trends, parishes are to trim their Sunday Mass schedules. For years, we have tried to offer as many Sunday Masses as humanly possible in order to accommodate the faithful. Yet, despite adding more and more Masses, fewer and fewer are attending.

At St. Peter, one Sunday Mass will be discontinued, and remaining Mass times will change. Some parishes have already made changes; some pastors have simply changed their schedules without parishioner input. The Strategic Plan leadership recommends though that pastors consult with their parishioners before making changes. During the recent shutdown, I introduced the news to all our faithful who have a presence on our Flocknotes social medium. Now that we are back together for Mass, I am able to put the word out more broadly.

There can be no reasonable expectation of consensus among us. The early returns (so-to-speak) from Flocknotes proved widely divergent. Everyone is invested in one's own "favorite" Mass. I ask you, however, to be more spiritually detached, to be less focused on your own interest, and to think objectively about the needed and coming Mass schedule change.

Initially, **please prayerfully consider a new Sunday Mass schedule to be, say, Saturday at 5:00 p.m.; Sunday at 9:00 a.m.; Sunday at 11:00 a.m.; and Sunday at 7:00 p.m. in Spanish.** That still leaves Fr. Tuttle doing four Sunday Masses, with three of them on Sunday. You may be interested to learn that according to Canon Law, a priest is only permitted to say two Masses a day unless the local ordinary (i.e. the bishop) grants express permission for the priest to say a third Mass if necessary, though it is not to be a regular occurrence. Of course, I did not have the luxury of saying only two Masses on Sundays, and even with St. Peter dropping a Sunday Mass, Fr. Tuttle will not have that luxury either. It takes a toll.

- **BAPTISM** – Baptisms are regularly scheduled EXCEPT DURING LENT: (1) At the 11:30 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of each month. (2) At 12:30 p.m. on the third Sunday of each month. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in English) on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Red Room. Parents must register in advance of the class. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in Spanish) on the last Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. in the Blue Room. There will be no Baptisms during Lent.
- **MARRIAGE** – Engaged couples should make an appointment with one of the priests or deacons at least six months in advance of their anticipated wedding. Participation in Pre-Cana and the Focus program are required. Only the priest or deacon who will be witnessing the marriage can set the date.
- **MINISTRY OF THE SICK** – If you are scheduled to be hospitalized, please call before your admission or contact the priest after Mass to receive the Sacrament. Please notify the Rectory whenever a member of your family or a neighbor is hospitalized so that the priests and deacons can visit. Hospital chaplains provide for the sacramental needs of patients. Please notify the Parish if anyone is confined to home and needs to be visited by the priest.
- **PARISH MEMBERSHIP** – New members, please stop by the Welcome Center Sunday, 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. or the Parish Office between 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday. Spanish-speaking members attending the 5:00 p.m. Mass, stop by the Welcome Center after Mass.
- **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)** – Classes held here from Fall into Spring on Thursday evenings for those fluent in English. Those fluent only in Spanish can attend classes here on Tuesday evenings. For English classes, please contact the Parish Secretary at jbiesecker@stpetercolumbus.com. For Spanish Classes, please contact Fr. Joseph Klee at (614) 294-7702, or frjosephklee@yahoo.com.
