PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION: The USCCB has designated the weekend of June 27 and 28 for Peter's Pence Collection (a.k.a. *The Holy Father's Collection*). The funds provide emergency relief assistance to those who suffer from war, oppression, disease, and natural disaster and are distributed in the Name of the Holy Father.

THE PASTOR IS DEAD. LONG LIVE THE PASTOR. Fr. Summers was asked by Bishop Brennan to become the new pastor of St. Agatha in Upper Arlington. Succeeding Fr. Summers here at St. Peter will be Fr. Chris Tuttle, who is currently a parochial vicar in the Portsmouth area. The move date for all priests changing places is Tuesday, July 14th. Fr. Summers intends to leave here after morning Mass on Monday, July 13th. Fr. Tuttle will move in the next day.

ADDITIONALLY. Fr. Mike Hartge, most recently Pastor of the Perry County Consortium, has been named the Vice-Chancellor of the Diocese. Bishop Brennan has asked him to live here at the St. Peter Rectory with Fr. Chris Tuttle, the incoming pastor. Fr. Hartge will only reside here; he has no assigned duties or responsibilities at St. Peter Parish. He will work Monday through Friday at the Chancery and work "supply" throughout the greater-Columbus parishes. He may from time-to-time say Mass here, but – as he described it to me – he expects to have no liturgical, administrative, or ministerial presence at St. Peter.

Deacon Hector Raymond, formerly a parishioner at Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Pickerington, has recently registered (with his wife) here at St. Peter Parish. He is currently on a leave of absence from the diaconate and has not been assigned by Bishop Brennan to serve here.

DURING THIS TIME OF EXTREME CHARITY, as Bishop Brennan calls it, please remember that that St. Peter Parish was paying bills, maintaining the Church building and the McEwan Center, making the full payroll for our staff, and assisting our sponsored charities and organizations.

FOR VARIOUS REASONS, our offertory collections over the first months of our fiscal year, before the COVID-19 Crisis hit, have been considerably lower than last year by about \$50,000. Because of the Stay-at-Home orders due to COVID 19 there were no in- person Mass collections taken up for 10 weeks. The simple truth is that Easter is one of the most giving of seasons, with more sustaining donations than at any time other than Christmas. Thank you to everyone who sent in donations during the shutdown! Continuing in this time of lower income but increased need, we ask you to prayerfully consider maintaining or increasing your offerings and donations to St. Peter Church. You may continue to give through your Pathways envelopes or, even better, may join our Faith Direct online giving program. There is a link on the church website homepage if you would like to sign up for Faith Direct.

IF SENDING YOUR OFFERING BY MAIL please do not mail cash. When sending a check, please note in the memo line or include a message noting how you would like the funds allocated.

DISPENSATION FROM BISHOP BRENNAN: All Catholics in the Diocese of Columbus are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass at least through September 13, 2020. If you are not feeling well, or have a fever, DO NOT COME to Mass. If you have risk factors for developing complications from COVID 19, DO NOT COME to Mass.

JUNE 29TH IS OUR PARISH'S PATRONAL FEAST DAY. There will be a Spanish Mass at 5:00 p.m. and an English Mass at 7:30 p.m.. There can be no social-gathering festivities this year. Weather-permitting, Fr. Summers wants to offer the 7:30 p.m. Mass outside on the front lawn. Assuming weather cooperates, please bring your own lawn chairs

MASS CHANGE UPDATE. No decision has yet been made on changes to our Mass schedule. If you wish to suggest anything, there is still time for you to do so. Only two parishioners have written in so far. Assuming there will be few responses, Fr. Summers will be able to put the new schedule into effect before he leaves, perhaps even as soon as the July 4/5 Mass.

If you plan on visiting the Parish Office, please wear a facemask, and prepare to have your temperature taken if you have not done so at home. The outer door will be unlocked from 9-12 and the number of people permitted into the office space will be limited. Please respect the 6' minimum distance between persons.

Parish Activities

ALL SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AT THE CHURCH AND MCEWAN CENTER are suspended until at least September or further notice due to the Coronavirus Pandemic.

- BAPTISM Baptisms are regularly scheduled <u>EXCEPT DURING</u> <u>LENT</u>: (1) At the 11:30 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of each month.
 (2) At 12:30 p.m. on the third Sunday of each month. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in English) on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Red Room. Parents must register in advance of the class. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in Spanish) on the last Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. in the Blue Room. There will be no Baptisms during Lent.
- MARRIAGE Engaged couples should make an appointment with one of the priests or deacons at least six months in advance of their anticipated wedding. Participation in Pre-Cana and the Focus program are required. Only the priest or deacon who will be witnessing the marriage can set the date.
- MINISTRY OF THE SICK If you are scheduled to be hospitalized, please call before your admission or contact the priest after Mass to receive the Sacrament. Please notify the Rectory whenever a member of your family or a neighbor is hospitalized so that the priests and deacons can visit. Hospital chaplains provide for the sacramental needs of patients. Please notify the Parish if anyone is confined to home and needs to be visited by the priest.


