Hello everyone!

I am excited to be here and I look forward to being with you and helping each of you grow closer to our Lord. As your Pastor and spiritual father, I want to be a part of your family. I look forward to getting to know you and hope that you will invite me to dinner at your house. I look forward to what the Lord has planned for us. Know of my prayers for all of you and I ask for your prayers as well. Please be patient with me during this time of transition.

I was born and raised here in Columbus. I am the eldest of seven children and all of my family live here in central Ohio. I have four nieces, two of which are my Goddaughters and one nephew who I Baptized last year. I am a graduate of St. Francis DeSales High School. I worked in the Golf industry for about a decade. I started here in Columbus at Brookside in a few different positions, then went to Naples, Florida for a couple of years as an Assistant Professional. After that, I worked exclusively as a Teaching Professional in Atlanta, Georgia for a year and in Phoenix, Arizona for about five years.

I first thought about becoming a Priest while serving Mass in the fourth grade. During my time in Phoenix, the Lord deepened that desire in me and I pursued it further. I started my eight years of formation for the Priesthood with the Diocese of Phoenix and transferred back to the Diocese of Columbus for my last five years of Formation. All seven years of my seminary formation were at the Pontifical College Josephinum. In 2018, Bishop Campbell ordained me and assigned me to the Scioto Catholic Consortium of parishes in Portsmouth, Ohio, for the last two years. I thank God for calling me to be a priest and now asking me to be your Pastor. It is with great joy that we will journey together and put our trust in the Lord's providence!

Additionally, I wanted to let you all know that we will have two other priests in our community. I introduced them at the Masses this last weekend. I will have them write a short biography and it will be put in the upcoming bulletin. Fr. Mike Hartge, the Vice Chancellor of the Diocese, is in residence here. Fr. Hartge is not assigned here, however, he will be helping out from time to time and is a part of the community, so, please welcome him if you see him. Additionally, the Bishop has assigned Fr. Ervens Mengelle, the Vice Rector, School of Theology at the Pontifical College Josephinum, to help me out. He is not here full-time, but rather Fr. Mengelle is specifically here to help me out with Hispanic ministry. He is a native of Argentina and was here in Columbus on assignment once before.

I am grateful that these two great priests will be present in our parish community and we look forward to helping you encounter Jesus Christ in your daily lives. Because wherever we are currently at in our spiritual lives, the Lord is calling each one of us to go deeper in our relationship with Him. He is calling each of us to grow in Faith. We are called to greatness! We are called to Holiness! We were made to be Saints!!!

Whenever we encounter the Lord there is the transformation of our hearts and our lives, if we are open to what He has in store for us. We see this throughout the Gospels: whenever a person encounters Jesus Christ, they are changed. *Only in Christ do we find peace and only in Jesus Christ are our deepest desires fulfilled.*

There is no greater, more intimate or more direct way to encounter the Lord on this earth than through the Sacraments and prayer. Therefore, as your Pastor and Spiritual Father, **this will be a parish of Encounter with the Lord!** The Sacrament of Confession will be offered more frequently. In addition to Holy Mass, there will be opportunities to be with the Lord in Adoration. For He is truly present to us in the Eucharist: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

In order to grow in our relationship with the Lord, we must be with Him. We must spend time with Him. We will have opportunities to experience the Love of God our Father and follow Jesus Christ through a joy filled living out of our Catholic Faith.

- **BAPTISM** – Baptisms are regularly scheduled EXCEPT DURING LENT: (1) At the 11:00 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of each month. (2) At 12:00 p.m. on the third Sunday of each month. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in English) on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Parents must pre-register. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in Spanish) on the last Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. Parents must pre-register. Call 614-889-2221 Ext. 100 to register. There will be no Baptisms during Lent.
- **MARRIAGE** – Engaged couples should make an appointment with one of the priests or deacons at least six months in advance of their anticipated wedding. Participation in Pre-Cana and the Focus program are required. Only the priest or deacon who will be witnessing the marriage can set the date.
- **MINISTRY OF THE SICK** – If you are scheduled to be hospitalized, please call before your admission or contact the priest after Mass to receive the Sacrament. Please notify the Office whenever a member of your family or a neighbor is hospitalized so that the priests and deacons can visit. Hospital chaplains provide for the sacramental needs of patients. Please notify the Parish if anyone is confined to home and needs to be visited by the priest.
- **PARISH MEMBERSHIP** – New members, please stop by the Welcome Center Sunday, 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. or the Parish Office between 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday. Spanish-speaking members attending the 5:00 p.m. Mass, stop by the Welcome Center after Mass.
- **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)** – Classes held here from Fall into Spring on Thursday evenings for those fluent in English. For English classes, please contact Jeff Brown at RCIA@stpetercolumbus.com. There are currently no RCIA classes available in Spanish at St. Peter.

ST. PETER ONLINE MASS: St. Peter Parish is live-streaming the Sunday 9:00 a.m. Mass and have plans to expand our live streaming. Please go to St. Peter Roman Catholic Church on Facebook to watch the Mass. If you do not have a Facebook account you can still reach the Live-Stream by going to the Church website (www.stpetercolumbus.com) and clicking on the Facebook icon near the bottom of the home page.

NEW MASS SCHEDULE. On Saturday, July 11th, and on every Saturday thereafter, the Sunday Vigil Mass is at 5:00 p.m. On Sunday, July 12th, and on every Sunday thereafter, the Sunday Masses are at 9:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and at 5:00 p.m. (in Spanish). Confessions will be held Saturdays 4:00-4:30 p.m., Sundays 4:00-4:30 p.m. in Spanish. Weekday Masses and First Saturday Mass times have not changed.

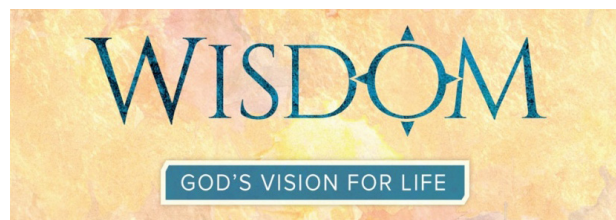
NEW OFFICE HOURS AND PROTOCOLS: The Parish Office is open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The Parish Office will accept visitors by appointment only from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Please call 614-889-2221, ext. 200 and leave a message if you have office business from 1:00-4:00. If you plan on visiting the Parish Office, please wear a facemask, and prepare to have your temperature taken if you have not done so at home. The outer door will be unlocked from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. and the number of people permitted into the office space will be limited. Please respect the 6' minimum distance between persons.

A BIG THANK-YOU TO THE CATHOLIC FOUNDATION! As some of you may know, the McEwan Center sanitary lines needed some major maintenance and repair work this spring. We applied for a grant to help defray the costs of this necessary repair and the Columbus Catholic Foundation came through with a \$10,000.00 grant. This grant helped enable us to complete the repairs to the sanitary lines. Also, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we applied for a Faith Formation Grant through the Columbus Catholic Foundation to purchase computers so that we may offer a digital remote classroom option for our PSR program. The Columbus Catholic Foundation granted St. Peter PSR \$3,000.00 to help make this option a reality. Thank you to The Catholic Foundation and all of the generous donors who make grants like this available.

Parish Activities

ST. PETER PARISH HAD A VERY SUCCESSFUL BLOODMOBILE in June in spite of the pandemic, achieving 116% of goal. Thank you for all who donated. Safety protocols were in place and all adhered to them with masks and proper spacing. We are preparing to repeat the process on August 10th, from 2:00 to 8:00 p.m. The need for blood is always great, so please consider donating this life saving gift. We will be set up in the gym. Everyone's temperature will be taken as they step in the door so if you sign up and then feel ill that day, you would not be expected to come. This was not a problem in June with several contributing to our success.

COVID-19 UPDATE FOR PSR:

As you know, we are facing many uncertainties during this COVID pandemic which make planning for our 2020-2021 religious education program extremely challenging. We have explored many options to find the best possible educational plan for St. Peter Parish School of Religion. While some programming changes are necessary, we continue to be fully committed to providing enriching PSR programs for your children. **Please note this plan is flexible and will continue to evolve as we receive additional information from both the State of Ohio and the Diocese of Columbus.** Be assured that we will follow health and safety guidelines for the safety of our students and volunteers.

Early Childhood PSR

- 3 year old and 4 year old Early Childhood Programs will not be offered during the 2020-2021 school year.
- Kindergarten students will not have class, but if desired, parents may choose to do our PSR Parent Led Home Study Option at regular tuition cost.
- First Grade Students will participate in a new pilot PSR blended program. Students will attend Sunday Mass at 9:00 a.m. each week with their families followed by a mini-lesson. Additional materials will be sent home each week to be completed and returned the following Sunday. Tuition is reduced to \$75.00 for this pilot program for this school year only. **First Grade PSR is required for First Communion.**
- Early Childhood PSR will begin classes Sunday, September 20.

Elementary PSR

To maintain safe distancing, we need to reduce the number of students physically in each classroom and in the building at any given time. In order to properly clean and sanitize between the two sessions on Mondays, class times will be reduced by 15 minutes. The 4:45 p.m. session will end at 5:45 p.m. and the evening session will be 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

- Grade 2 students will attend class in person every week as usual.
- Grades 3-6 Elementary PSR program will attend class in person every week as usual. If class size exceeds capacity, that class will move to a hybrid approach where students attend traditional PSR classes in person every other week. On alternate weeks they will participate in e-learning via live stream. Students in Grades 3-6 may participate in the Parent Led Home Study PSR Option if desired at full tuition cost.
- Elementary PSR will begin classes Monday, September 21.

Jr. High PSR and RCIA Teens

To maintain safe distancing, we need to reduce the number of students physically in each classroom and in the building at any given time.

- Grade 7 Jr. High PSR program will attend class in person every week as usual. If class size exceeds capacity, that class will move to a hybrid approach where students attend traditional PSR classes in person every other week. On alternate weeks they will participate in e-learning via live stream. Students in Grades 7 may participate in the Parent Led Home Study PSR Option if desired at full tuition cost. **Grade 7 PSR is required for Confirmation.**
- Grade 8 students and RCIA Teens will attend class in person every week as usual.
- Jr. High PSR & RCIA Teens will begin classes Wednesday, September 30.

Please register for PSR as soon as possible so that we may adequately prepare for the coming school year. Registration forms are available on the parish website at <https://stpetercolumbus.com>. Since email is our primary form of communication, **PSR registration is not complete without a current valid email address.** Remember, tuition increases August 1 and registrations **will not** be accepted after August 15.
