DISPENSATION FROM BISHOP BRENNAN: All Catholics in the Diocese of Columbus are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass at least through September 13, 2020. If you are not feeling well, or have a fever, DO NOT COME to Mass. If you have risk factors for developing complications from COVID 19, DO NOT COME to Mass.

BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL "Living the Joy of the Gospel," the theme of the Bishop's Annual Appeal, inspires us, as people of faith, to share joyfully the Good News of Christ to those who most need to feel His love. Works of kindness and assistance, sometimes in the smallest way, can bring about a profound change in a person's life. Through the Bishop's Annual Appeal, we have an opportunity to bring about a positive change in the lives of many of God's people. Through your generosity, you are supporting the various ministries and programs that are vital in spreading His love. Next week is Commitment Weekend for the Appeal, at which time you can make your gift or pledge. Our parish has been asked to raise \$174,365.50. We can accomplish this if, after prayerful consideration, everyone gives what they can. Any amount raised over our goal will be returned to our parish to be used for our particular needs.

CONGRATULATIONS FIRST COMMUNICANTS! On Saturday, June 27th, 59 children received their First Holy Communion. Please say a prayer of thanksgiving and a prayer of praise for the gift of Christ's Body and Blood given them.

THE PASTOR IS DEAD. LONG LIVE THE PASTOR. Fr. Summers was asked by Bishop Brennan to become the new pastor of St. Agatha in Upper Arlington. Succeeding Fr. Summers here at St. Peter will be Fr. Chris Tuttle, who is currently a parochial vicar in the Portsmouth area. The move date for all priests changing places is Tuesday, July 14th. Fr. Summers intends to leave here after morning Mass on Monday, July 13th. Fr. Tuttle will move in the next day.

ADDITIONALLY. Fr. Mike Hartge, most recently Pastor of the Perry County Consortium, has been named the Vice-Chancellor of the Diocese. Bishop Brennan has asked him to live here at the St. Peter Rectory with Fr. Chris Tuttle, the incoming pastor. Fr. Hartge will only reside here; he has no assigned duties or responsibilities at St. Peter Parish. He will work Monday through Friday at the Chancery and work "supply" throughout the greater-Columbus parishes. He may from time-to-time say Mass here, but – as he described it to me – he expects to have no liturgical, administrative, or ministerial presence at St. Peter.

Deacon Hector Raymond, formerly a parishioner at Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Pickerington, has recently registered (with his wife) here at St. Peter Parish. He is currently on a leave of absence from the diaconate and has not been assigned by Bishop Brennan to serve here.

Fr. Joseph Klee has ably and tirelessly served in Hispanic Ministry here at St. Peter for the last two years. On June 22nd Bishop Brennan relieved Fr. Klee of that responsibility. Fr. Summers will preside at the Sunday Mass in Spanish until he leaves when Fr. Tuttle will take over. Fr. Klee has been a great help to our Hispanic parishioners and to Fr. Summers. We thank him for his time with us and wish him well.

FOR VARIOUS REASONS, our offertory collections over the first months of our fiscal year, before the COVID-19 Crisis hit, have been considerably lower than last year by about \$50,000. Because of the Stay-at-Home orders due to COVID 19 there were no in-person Mass collections taken up for 10 weeks. The simple truth is that Easter is one of the most giving of seasons, with more sustaining donations than at any time other than Christmas. Thank you to everyone who sent in donations during the shutdown! Continuing in this time of lower income but increased need, we ask you to prayerfully consider maintaining or increasing your offerings and donations to St. Peter Church. You may continue to give through your Pathways envelopes or, even better, may join our Faith Direct online giving program. There is a link on the church website homepage if you would like to sign up for Faith Direct.

IF SENDING YOUR OFFERING BY MAIL please do not mail cash. When sending a check, please note in the memo line or include a message noting how you would like the funds allocated.

MASS CHANGE UPDATE. No decision has yet been made on changes to our Mass schedule. If you wish to suggest anything, there is still time for you to do so. Only two parishioners have written in so far. Assuming there will be few responses, Fr. Summers will be able to put the new schedule into effect before he leaves, perhaps even as soon as the July 4/5 Masses.

ST. PETER ONLINE MASS: St. Peter Parish will be live-streaming the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass on Facebook. Please go to St. Peter Roman Catholic Church on Facebook to watch the Mass. If you do not have a Facebook account you can still reach the Live-Stream by going to the Church website (www.stpetercolumbus.com) and clicking on the Facebook icon near the bottom of the home page.

- **BAPTISM** – Baptisms are regularly scheduled EXCEPT DURING LENT: (1) At the 11:30 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of each month. (2) At 12:30 p.m. on the third Sunday of each month. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in English) on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Red Room. Parents must register in advance of the class. There is a Pre-Baptism class (in Spanish) on the last Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. in the Blue Room. There will be no Baptisms during Lent.
- **MARRIAGE** – Engaged couples should make an appointment with one of the priests or deacons at least six months in advance of their anticipated wedding. Participation in Pre-Cana and the Focus program are required. Only the priest or deacon who will be witnessing the marriage can set the date.
- **MINISTRY OF THE SICK** – If you are scheduled to be hospitalized, please call before your admission or contact the priest after Mass to receive the Sacrament. Please notify the Rectory whenever a member of your family or a neighbor is hospitalized so that the priests and deacons can visit. Hospital chaplains provide for the sacramental needs of patients. Please notify the Parish if anyone is confined to home and needs to be visited by the priest.
- **PARISH MEMBERSHIP** – New members, please stop by the Welcome Center Sunday, 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. or the Parish Office between 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday. Spanish-speaking members attending the 5:00 p.m. Mass, stop by the Welcome Center after Mass.
- **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)** – Classes held here from Fall into Spring on Thursday evenings for those fluent in English. Those fluent only in Spanish can attend classes here on Tuesday evenings. For English classes, please contact the Parish Secretary at jbiesecker@stpetercolumbus.com.
