

Hello everyone!

I am excited to be here and I look forward to being with you and helping each of you grow closer to our Lord. As your Pastor and spiritual father, I want to be a part of your family. I look forward to getting to know you and hope that you will invite me to dinner at your house. I look forward to what the Lord has planned for us. Know of my prayers for all of you and I ask for your prayers as well. Please be patient with me during this time of transition.

I was born and raised here in Columbus. I am the eldest of seven children and all of my family live here in central Ohio. I have four nieces, two of which are my Goddaughters and one nephew who I Baptized last year. I am a graduate of St. Francis DeSales High School. I worked in the Golf industry for about a decade. I started here in Columbus at Brookside in a few different positions, then went to Naples, Florida for a couple of years as an Assistant Professional. After that, I worked exclusively as a Teaching Professional in Atlanta, Georgia for a year and in Phoenix, Arizona for about five years.

I first thought about becoming a Priest while serving Mass in the fourth grade. During my time in Phoenix, the Lord deepened that desire in me and I pursued it further. I started my eight years of formation for the Priesthood with the Diocese of Phoenix and transferred back to the Diocese of Columbus for my last five years of Formation. All seven years of my seminary formation were at the Pontifical College Josephinum. In 2018, Bishop Campbell ordained me and assigned me to the Scioto Catholic Consortium of parishes in Portsmouth, Ohio for the last two years. I thank God for calling me to be a priest and now asking me to be your Pastor. It is with great joy that we will journey together and put our trust in the Lord's providence!

Additionally, I wanted to let you all know that we will have two other priests in our community. I introduced them at the Masses this last weekend. I will have them write a short biography and it will be put in the upcoming bulletin. Fr. Mike Hartge, the Vice Chancellor of the Diocese, is in residence here. Fr. Hartge is not assigned here, however, he will be helping out from time to time and is a part of the community, so, please welcome him if you see him. Additionally, the Bishop has assigned Fr. Ervens Mengelle, the Vice Rector, School of Theology at the Pontifical College Josephinum, to help me out. He is not here full time, but rather Fr. Mengelle is specifically here to help me out with Hispanic ministry. He is a native of Argentina and was here in Columbus on assignment once before.

I am grateful that these two great priests will be present in our parish community and we look forward to helping you encounter Jesus Christ in your daily lives. Because wherever we are currently at in our spiritual lives, the Lord is calling each one of us to go deeper in our relationship with Him. He is calling each of us to grow in Faith. We are called to greatness! We are called to Holiness! We were made to be Saints!!!

Whenever we encounter the Lord there is the transformation of our hearts and our lives, if we are open to what He has in store for us. We see this throughout the Gospels: whenever a person encounters Jesus Christ, they are changed. *Only in Christ do we find peace and only in Jesus Christ are our deepest desires fulfilled*.

There is no greater, more intimate or more direct way to encounter the Lord on this earth than through the Sacraments and prayer. Therefore, as your Pastor and Spiritual Father, **this will be a parish of Encounter with the Lord!** The Sacrament of Confession will be offered more frequently. In addition to Holy Mass, there will be opportunities to be with the Lord in Adoration. For He is truly present to us in the Eucharist: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

In order to grow in our relationship with the Lord, we must be with Him. We must spend time with Him. We will have opportunities to experience the Love of God our Father and follow Jesus Christ through a joy filled living out of our Catholic Faith.

May the Lord shower his blessings upon each of you!

Estoy emocionado de estar aquí y deseo estar con ustedes y ayudarlos a cada uno a acercarse a nuestro Señor. Como su pastor y padre espiritual, quiero ser parte de su familia. Espero conocerlos y espero que me inviten a cenar a su casa. Espero ver lo que el Señor ha planeado para nosotros. Sepan de mis oraciones por todos ustedes y yo también pido sus oraciones. Por favor tengan paciencia conmigo durante este tiempo de transición.

Nací y crecí aquí en Columbus. Soy el mayor de siete hijos y toda mi familia vive aquí en el centro de Ohio. Tengo cuatro sobrinas, dos de las cuales son mis ahijadas y un sobrino a quien bauticé el año pasado. Me gradué del High School St. Francis DeSales. Trabajé en la industria del golf durante aproximadamente una década. Comencé aquí en Columbus en Brookside en algunos puestos diferentes, luego fui a Nápoles, Florida, durante un par de años como Asistente Profesional. Después de eso, trabajé exclusivamente como profesional docente en Atlanta, Georgia durante un año y en Phoenix, Arizona, durante unos cinco años.

Al principio pensé en convertirme en sacerdote mientras servía en misa en cuarto grado. Durante mi tiempo en Phoenix, el Señor profundizó ese deseo en mí y lo perseguí aún más. Comencé mis ocho años de formación para el Sacerdocio con la Diócesis de Phoenix y me transferí de regreso a la Diócesis de Columbus para mis últimos cinco años de formación. Los siete años de mi formación en el seminario fueron en el Colegio Pontificio Josephinum. En el 2018, el obispo Campbell me ordenó y me asignó al Consorcio Católico de parroquias Scioto en Portsmouth, Ohio, durante los últimos dos años. Además, quería que todos supieran que tendremos otros dos sacerdotes en nuestra comunidad. Los presenté en las misas este último fin de semana. Haré que escriban una breve biografía y se incluirá en el próximo boletín. El p. Mike Hartge, el vicecanciller de la diócesis, reside aquí. El p. Hartge no está asignado aquí, sin embargo, estará ayudando de vez en cuando y es parte de la comunidad, así que, por favor, denle la bienvenida si lo ven. Además, el obispo ha asignado al p. Ervins Mengelle, vicerrector de teología del Colegio Pontificio Josephinum, para ayudarme. Él no está aquí a tiempo completo, sino más bien el p. Mengelle está específicamente aquí para ayudarme con el ministerio hispano. Es originario de Argentina y estuvo aquí en Columbus una vez antes.

Estoy agradecido de que estos dos grandes sacerdotes estarán presentes en nuestra comunidad parroquial y esperamos poder ayudarlos a ustedes a encontrar a Jesucristo en su vida diaria. COVID-19 UPDATE FOR PSR:

Please note this plan is flexible and will continue to evolve as we receive additional information from both the State of Ohio and the Diocese of Columbus. Be assured that we will follow health and safety guidelines for the safety of our students and volunteers.

Early Childhood PSR

- First Grade Students will participate in a new pilot PSR blended program. Students will attend Sunday Mass at 9:00 a.m. each week with their families followed by a mini-lesson. Additional materials will be sent home each week to be completed and returned the following Sunday. Tuition is reduced to \$75.00 for this pilot program for this school year only. First Grade PSR is required for First Communion.
- Parent Home Study Early Childhood PSR Option is also available for students in Grade 1 if desired.

Elementary PSR

To maintain safe distancing, we need to reduce the number of students physically in each classroom and in the building at any given time. In order to properly clean and sanitize between the two sessions on Mondays, class times will be reduced by 15 minutes. The 4:45 p.m. session will end at 5:45 p.m. and the evening session will be 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

- Grade 2 students will attend class in person every week as usual.
- Grades 3-6 Elementary PSR program will attend class in person every week as usual. If class size exceeds capacity, that class
 will move to a hybrid approach where students attend traditional PSR classes in person every other week. On alternate weeks
 they will participate in e-learning via live stream. Students in Grades 3-6 may participate in the Parent Led Home Study PSR
 Option if desired at full tuition cost.
- Elementary PSR will begin classes Monday, September 21.

Jr. High PSR and RCIA Teens

To maintain safe distancing, we need to reduce the number of students physically in each classroom and in the building at any given time.

- Grade 7 Jr. High PSR program will attend class in person every week as usual. If class size exceeds capacity, that class will move to a hybrid approach where students attend traditional PSR classes in person every other week. On alternate weeks they will participate in e-learning via live stream. Students in Grades 7 may participate in the Parent Led Home Study PSR Option if desired at full tuition cost. Grade 7 PSR is required for Confirmation.
- Grade 8 students will attend class in person every week as usual. Because of the COVID pandemic, students in Grade 8 may participate in the Parent Led Home Study PSR Option.
- RCIA Teens will attend class in person every week as usual.
- Jr. High PSR & RCIA Teens will begin classes Wednesday, September 30.

Please register for PSR as soon as possible so that we may adequately prepare for the coming school year. Registration forms are available on the parish website at https://stpetercolumbus.com. Since email is our primary form of communication, PSR registration is not complete without a current valid email address.

Last day to register for reduced tuition is Monday, August 3 – No exceptions. Tuition increases August 4 and registrations will not be accepted after August 15.

PSR VOLUNTEERS ARE THE HEART OF OUR PROGRAM: VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: The health and safety guidelines due to the COVID pandemic necessitates smaller class sizes and therefore more classes and many additional volunteers this year. The number of volunteers will determine how many classrooms we are able to open. Please prayerfully consider volunteering your time and talent as a PSR volunteer. Teachers are tuition exempt for their children and aides pay only \$30.00 per student. 


