From the Pastor's Desk

I wanted to touch upon four things in this weekend's article. First, we have entered the month of November. For us as Catholics, this month is a time to pray for our beloved dead, asking God to receive them in heaven. At Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc, we have books in the narthex for parishioners to write the names of loved ones who have died. Throughout November, we will pray for these individuals and for all members of our communities who have passed away.

Second, November 5 through November 11 is National Vocation Awareness Week. We believe that God calls everyone to a specific vocation. With faith and courage, we listen to that call and open our hearts to God's design for our life. National Vocation Awareness Week gives us the opportunity to encourage young people to remain open to the call to priesthood, religious life, marriage, or single life. In particular, if you know someone who would make an excellent priest or religious sister, please encourage that person to pray about that possibility.

Third, I am asking that parishioners of Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc consider very intentionally their financial contributions in 2024. The responsible and generous stewardship of the financial blessings we have received from God (Stewardship of Treasure) is critical to the life of our churches. We have developed an Offertory Commitment Form that will help parishioners discern how best to support their parish. Thank you in advance for filling out an Offertory Commitment Form and for returning it to the parish later this month.

Fourth, please be sure to vote this week if you have not done so already. Both Issue 1 and Issue 2 are moral issues, so the Church is encouraging people of goodwill to vote No. May the Lord bless Ohio with a deep conviction for the sanctity of all human life. And may He grant health and safety to communities throughout our state.
