ALL trained EMHCs are **MANDATED** to participate in one of the Rites of Commission that will take place during all Masses on the Solemnity of Pentecost, on Saturday, May 18, and Sunday, May 19. In the Catholic Diocese of Columbus, EMHCs are commissioned for a two-year term of service, after which the EMHCs are mandated to renew the training and be recommissioned.
