FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I love the Fourth of July – cookouts, fireworks, and family gatherings! Independence Day is also a wonderful opportunity to give thanks to God for the freedoms and privileges we enjoy in the United States. REMEMBERING SAINT PETER SAINT JOAN OF ARC: WHAT IS A LEGACY GIFT?

In a May bulletin, the SPSJOA Legacy Society was introduced to parishioners as a unified recognition program of legacy gifts for all parishioners of our new parish, St. Peter St. Joan of Arc. Parishioners who provide a legacy gift to the parish and notify the parish of such gifts become members of the Society. But what is a legacy gift? Simply stated, a legacy gift describes the donor's commitment to transfer a portion of the donor's accumulated wealth to a qualified religious, educational, or charitable organization at the time of the donor's death. For our purpose, this would be a gift to the parish from a parishioner's estate. A legacy gift is generally made by means of a formal instrument which might include a will, trust, insurance policy, retirement plan, gift annuity, or donor-advised fund.

Legacy planning is not a "fundraising" program, but rather it is faith-based in discipleship and stewardship. As we mature in our discipleship, we recognize our mission to pass our faith onto future generations. We do this through evangelization – knowing and understanding our faith well and sharing that faith with others. Just as important, as disciples of Christ, we must recognize and be grateful for all the glorious gifts that have been provided to us during our lifetimes. As grateful disciples, we return a portion of the gifts we have accumulated over our lifetimes to our parish and other charitable organizations. Such important gifts will touch the lives that come after us and build our faith for generations to come.

Wealth is not a requirement for legacy giving. All grateful disciples have some means to share a portion of accumulated assets regardless of their size.

If any parishioner has already provided a gift to either St. Peter or St. Joan of Arc but the parish has not been notified, please contact Stephanie Grieser, Director of Stewardship, so that you can be added to the SPSJOA Legacy Society. Also, contact Stephanie if you would like more information on legacy planning (sgrieser@stjoanofarcpowell.org or by telephone at either campus office).

Mark your calendars for "My Last Wishes Seminar," which will be held on the morning of Saturday, November 16, 2024, and will include topics like choosing a Catholic cemetery, making funeral arrangements, planning the funeral liturgy, estate planning and legacy planning.
