From the Pastor's Desk

This weekend's gospel reminds us of the importance of stewardship. God has blessed us abundantly. Now, we have the responsibility to use well the blessings we have received. In other words, God calls us to share generously our Time, Treasure, Talent, and Testimony. Such generosity grows our faith. The paradox of the Christian life is that the more we give, the more we receive. When we invest heavily in the Kingdom of God, we open ourselves up to an increase in God's grace, mercy, and love. Pouring ourselves out is what fills us up.

Speaking of blessings, we take time this week as a nation to give thanks for all that God has done for us. Thanksgiving Day reminds me of the central mystery of our religion: the Eucharist. The word "Eucharist" is Greek for "Thanksgiving." Just as we gather with family and friends around the table for a feast on Thanksgiving Day, in every Mass we pray with the Church around the altar and share a sacred meal. Though I am not the one cooking the turkey in my home on Thanksgiving, I understand how much sacrifice it takes to prepare a delicious meal. Likewise, Jesus' tremendous sacrifice on the cross is the reason we are blessed with the gift of His Body and Blood. Know that I am giving thanks to God for you this Thursday (and every day)!

One last note: I wanted to give thanks in a public way to our parishes' musicians. I highlight them this weekend because the Feast of Saint Cecilia, the patron saint of musicians, is November 23. Thank you, musicians, for all that you do to help us worship at Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc! Our churches are indebted to your dedicated service. Please persevere in your good works.

Update on "The Appeal"
