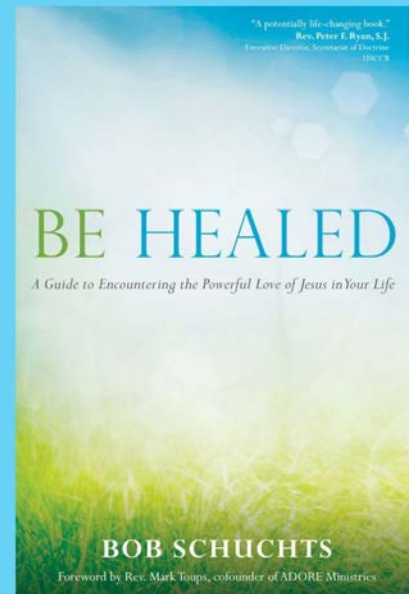

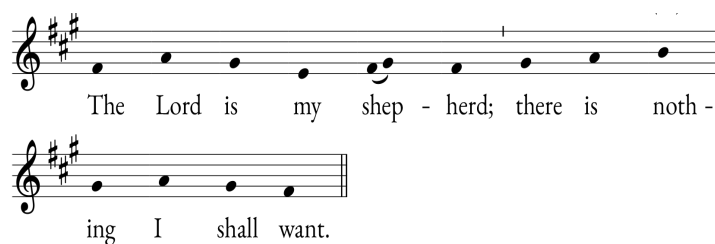

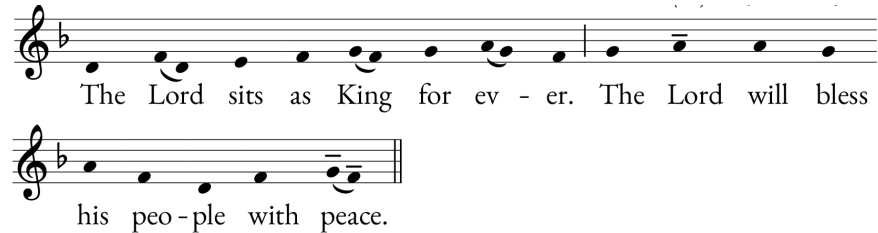

From the Pastor's Desk

The Church throughout the world celebrates the Feast of Christ the King this weekend. This solemnity holds a special place in my heart because I was assigned to Christ the King Church for more than a quarter of my life. Jesus taught me much during that time. Most importantly, he taught me that he indeed is the King. He is the one in charge, so I can let go of control. Peace floods our life when we allow Jesus to be the King of our heart and home, our work, and our Church. May Christ continue to reign powerfully over Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc!

Next Sunday, the Church will enter into a new liturgical season: Advent. This is a time of preparation for the coming of the Lord. I encourage you to use this week to discern carefully how you will spend the upcoming twenty-two days of Advent (December 3 through December 24). Ask the Holy Spirit what spiritual practices you should take up. Maybe you could make time for a daily devotional or for reading the Scriptures. Perhaps you could serve the less fortunate or be more present to your family. God may be asking you to fast from a particular comfort in order to be more aware of his presence. The goal of the Advent season is to grow in the spiritual life and to focus our hearts on receiving Christ at Christmas.

I want to conclude by reminding everyone that our new Mass schedule begins next weekend. This sort of change is never easy! While some people have approached me with gratitude, saying that they appreciate the new schedule, others have expressed frustration. Please know how much I appreciate everyone's commitment to the celebration of the Eucharist; I recognize the effort parishioners put into going to church. Thank you in advance for accepting this new Mass schedule as we further integrate Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc.

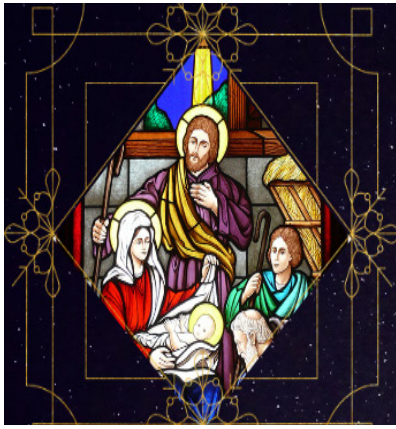
Mass will be at 9 a.m. followed by adoration, the rosary, Fatima prayers, and confession.
