From the Pastor's Desk

Let me take a moment to give you an update on a few things at St. Peter and St. Joan of Arc. I am blessed with a number of teams and committees that are assisting me.

- 1. The Collaboration Team, originally formed in January 2023, continues to meet regularly. This group is currently planning parish-wide gatherings in late January to further discuss the merging of St. Peter and St. Joan of Arc.
- 2. There is a newly formed Leadership Team that helps me understand and organize all the various ministries and activities taking place in the life of our communities.
- 3. The "Expanding the Foundation" Committee has been reconstituted. The work of this group is to craft a plan for our parishes as we move forward with the capital campaign that was initiated at St. Joan of Arc in 2019.
- 4. In the very near future, the Liturgy Committee will begin meeting to discuss liturgical celebrations and the training of our liturgical ministers (e.g., readers, servers, etc.).
- 5. Last but not least, the Hispanic Ministry Council has a monthly meeting. This group focuses on the events and ministries that are geared toward our Spanish-speaking parishioners.

The Hispanic Ministry Council has members from St. Peter Church only. However, all the other teams and committees I mentioned are comprised of parishioners from both St. Peter and St. Joan of Arc. My goal is to surround myself with a great number of people who can build a culture of communication and facilitate growth in our churches.

Please pray that the Holy Spirit inspires and directs these advisory groups! I want the Holy Spirit to touch the lives of everyone at St. Peter and St. Joan of Arc so that they know that this is indeed their spiritual home. If we allow the Holy Spirit to lead, we can together build up God's Kingdom in our churches.
