From the Pastor's Desk

We have entered the blessed season of Advent. Like Lent, this is a season of preparation: we are readying ourselves spiritually for the coming of the Lord. To have a more meaningful Advent season, let me recommend some helpful practices.

First, make time for silence. Set aside distractions each day and listen attentively to the voice of God in your heart. The Lord desires to speak to us, but we have to be quiet to hear him. Perhaps you can discover silence in the Adoration Chapel at Saint Peter or Saint Joan of Arc during the month of December.

Second, make time for service. Consider how your kindness and generosity could benefit someone in need. When we sacrifice our time and energy to lift up others, we allow our love for God to grow. Maybe you can focus your attention on serving family members or friends. That is to say, your service during Advent could simply be to strengthen important relationships in your life.

Third, make time for Mary. Our heavenly Mother always leads us to a deeper relationship with her Son. We do well to focus our attention on her example and to ponder with her the immensity of God's love. The rosary is a Catholic devotion designed precisely for this. Involving Mary in your Advent prayer is a sure-fire way to prepare for Jesus' coming.

Speaking of the Blessed Virgin Mary, I want to end by reminding you that this Friday, December 8, is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, and Catholics throughout the world will honor Mary by attending Mass. Find a Mass time that works for you, and during that liturgy ask the Mother of God to pray for you, your family, and our church community.




