## From the Pastor's Desk

In this weekend's Gospel, we hear one of the most well-known Scripture verses from our religious tradition. Jesus says to us: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who *believes in him* might not perish but might have eternal life" (John 3:16).

During this season of Lent, it is worthwhile to ponder what it means to *believe in Jesus*. The Catechism of the Catholic Church speaks of Christian belief as a commitment of our whole self to the Lord. Having authentic faith in Jesus means surrendering our entire existence to him.

Such faith necessarily entails an intimate relationship. To have faith is to enter into a loving communion with Jesus who desires us, and our belief is an expression of our desire for him. This mutual desire is experienced in our daily prayer and the reception of the grace-giving sacraments of the Church.

In John 3:16, Jesus is inviting us to receive the love of God the Father. We do so when we place our hearts in the hands of his Son. We, people of faith, are blessed with this tremendous gift: the ability to trust Jesus with everything. Such faith opens us up to eternal life.

# THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

## FIRST READING

2 Chr 36: 14-16, 19-23

In those days, all the princes of Judah, the priests, and the people  
added infidelity to infidelity,  
practicing all the abominations of the nations  
and polluting the LORD's temple  
which he had consecrated in Jerusalem.

Early and often did the LORD, the God of their fathers,  
send his messengers to them,  
for he had compassion on his people and his dwelling place.

But they mocked the messengers of God,  
despised his warnings, and scoffed at his prophets,  
until the anger of the LORD against his people was so inflamed  
that there was no remedy.

Their enemies burnt the house of God,  
tore down the walls of Jerusalem,  
set all its palaces afire,  
and destroyed all its precious objects.

Those who escaped the sword were carried captive to Babylon,  
where they became servants of the king of the Chaldeans and his sons  
until the kingdom of the Persians came to power.

All this was to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah:  
"Until the land has retrieved its lost sabbaths,  
during all the time it lies waste it shall have rest  
while seventy years are fulfilled."

In the first year of Cyrus, king of Persia,  
in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah,  
the LORD inspired King Cyrus of Persia  
to issue this proclamation throughout his kingdom,  
both by word of mouth and in writing:  
"Thus says Cyrus, king of Persia:  
All the kingdoms of the earth  
the LORD, the God of heaven, has given to me,  
and he has also charged me to build him a house  
in Jerusalem, which is in Judah.

Whoever, therefore, among you belongs to any part of his people,  
let him go up, and may his God be with him!"



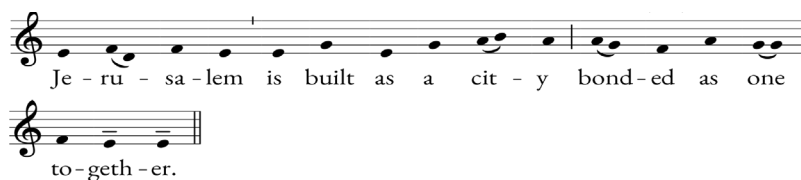

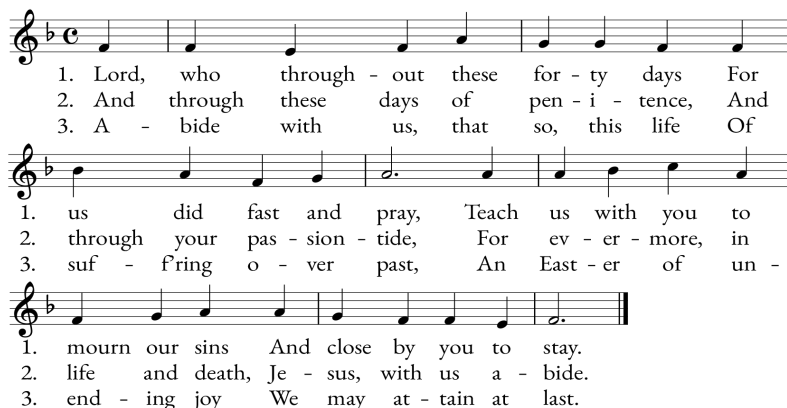
