It is a blessing to be pastor of the church with the best Fish Fry in the entire city. I plan on serving food this Friday, showing my gratitude for all the volunteers who make the Fish Fry possible.

On Saturday, March 23, all my brothers from Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc are invited to the Men's Breakfast. Mass is at 8:30 a.m. at Saint Joan of Arc, which will be followed by a delicious meal at 9:00 a.m. If you are unfamiliar with the Men's Ministry at the parish, this would be a perfect introduction. All newcomers are welcome!

Lastly, let me wish you a Blessed and Happy Saint Patrick's Day! May this great bishop of Ireland smile down upon us and intercede powerfully for Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc.

St. Teresa's Outreach Update

The ministry of St. Teresa's Outreach is part of our parish's commitment to the poor. We are incredibly grateful for the amazing generosity of our parishioners who support our important work.

Your donations of food and toiletries help our local food pantries serve so many who are struggling to feed their families and make ends meet. Your thoughtful donations of candles, snacks, nonperishables, and canned goods bring nourishment and comfort to those living on the streets who are served by our Homeless Ministry each Saturday, rain or shine.

Participating in our Thanksgiving and Lenten food box drives, purchasing subs for St. Lawrence Haven, and supporting our special items collections, you are truly the hands and feet of our Lord Jesus Christ to those in need.

In the past several weeks:

- 14 large boxes of food and 7 boxes of clothing were sent to J.O.I.N. in downtown Columbus
- 24 crates of food to the Help My Neighbors food pantry, across from Saint Peter
- St. Vincent de Paul at Saint Peter assisted 15 individuals and 9 families with rent and utility expenses, funeral expenses, and prepaid Kroger Cards.
- 18 crates of sandwiches were delivered to St. Joseph Cathedral's Backdoor Ministry
- Our food collection at Saint Peter's campus helped serve 361 families at Holy Rosary/St. John Food Pantry
- The Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc Men's Club Super Bowl Sub Sale collected \$4,140 in donations, resulting in 230 subs donated to St. Lawrence Haven in downtown Columbus
- The Bloodmobile at Saint Peter's campus collected 74 units of blood for the American Red Cross
- The Lenten Food Drive was a wonderful success. Saint Peter's campus collected 7 donated carloads evenly between Smokey Row Food Pantry and St. John Food Pantry. Saint Joan of Arc's campus donated 344 food boxes and 100 hams to Home for Families, and 55 boxes to Help My Neighbors. 
