
#### **5th Sunday Collection**

I want to wish everyone a blessed Easter! We rejoice because Christ has conquered death by rising from the grave. Christians sing "Alleluia," an ancient Hebrew word that captures our sentiment – it means "Praise the Lord." We praise and thank our risen Lord for the gift of new life that he offers us through his Death and Resurrection.

There is indeed new life in our community. Bishop Fernandes has officially announced that a new parish will be erected this summer: Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc Parish. This unified community will continue the legacy of faith at both churches while fostering greater collaboration among us. I am grateful to everyone who has shown openness to this momentous opportunity in the history of our parish, and I pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to guide our efforts to build God's Kingdom together.

Let me conclude by drawing your attention to our new parish logo (shown on the front of the bulletin). It contains both a key and sword, symbolizing our two patron saints, Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc. The flame between those two symbols reminds us of the martyrdom of Saint Joan of Arc and the tongues of fire that fell on Saint Peter at Pentecost. There are three parts to the flame which signify: 1. Saint Peter Parish, 2. Saint Joan of Arc Parish, and 3. the new combined reality of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc Parish.

May our hearts burn with greater love for God as we enter into this Easter season. When I sing "Alleluia" in these days, I think of Christ's goodness, as well as the great privilege of being pastor of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc.

#### Bishop Fernandes' Decree for Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc

Bishop Fernandes recently promulgated a decree of suppression for Saint Peter and Saint Joan of Arc. This will take effect on June 30th, 2024. A new parish called Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc will be erected the following day, July 1st, 2024.

A great deal of fellowship and collaboration have already been established in our Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc parish community. We are excited to build on the momentum of our combined community.

The bishop is grateful to the clergy and faithful who provided important insight when contributing to the plan for Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc. Futhermore, the Presbyteral Council of the Diocese of Columbus advised the bishop while considering the need to consolidate resources and better utilize the limited numbers of available priests in our diocese.
