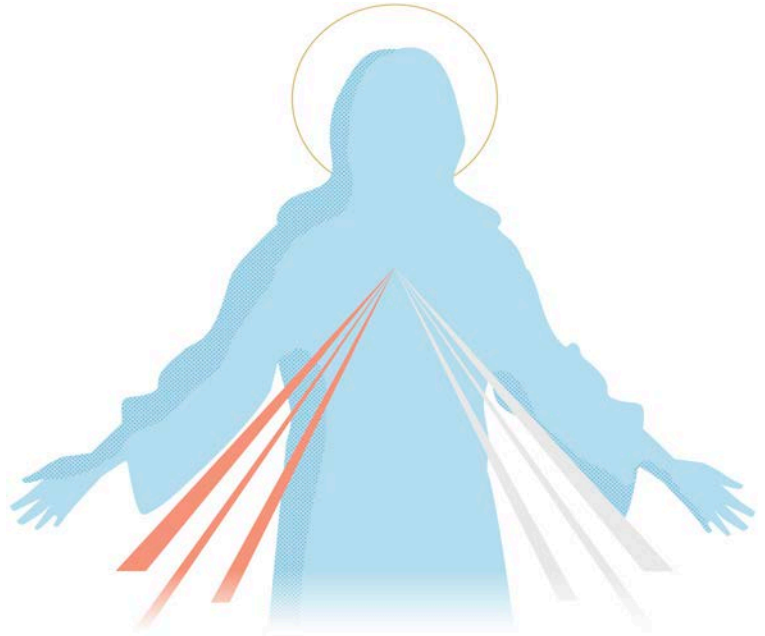

From the Pastor's Desk

I wish everyone a very blessed Easter! Yes, we are still celebrating the Lord's resurrection and his triumph over the tomb. The liturgical season of Easter continues for fifty days, culminating with the Solemnity of Pentecost. This is a joyful time of year for Christians, and our song remains "Alleluia!"

Please note that throughout the Easter season, we will exercise two different options for the liturgy. We will use the Sprinkling Rite instead of the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass. This is a simple liturgical action that reminds us of our baptism. We will also profess our faith by reciting the Apostles Creed instead of the Nicene Creed. This more succinct summary of our faith is closely associated with the sacrament of baptism as well.

The second Sunday of Easter is called Divine Mercy Sunday. We ponder the infinite mercy of God and our call to extend that mercy to others. Devotion to Divine Mercy began in 1931 when Jesus appeared to a Polish nun, Saint Faustina. Through this holy woman, the Church received a tender message of mercy in which Jesus emphasized the breadth of his compassion. We will have a bilingual Holy Hour for Divine Mercy at 3:00 p.m. this Sunday, April 7, at Saint Joan of Arc.

Let me end with a quick word about the total eclipse of the sun that will occur this Monday, April 8. This is an opportunity for us to give thanks for the marvelous design of God's creation. We will need special glasses to observe this natural phenomenon safely while on Earth. In heaven, however, we will not need to shield our eyes as we gaze upon the brilliant face of God. "The Lord let his face shine upon you, and be gracious to you! The Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace!" (Numbers 6: 25-26).

How to pray The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. (Optional*) Pray,

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. "Our Father,"

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

"Hail Mary,"

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

"And The Apostle's Creed."

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead....

...I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

4. On the Our Father beads pray,

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

5. On the Hail Mary Beads pray,

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

6. Pray three times,

4. Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Optional*)

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

Close with the Sign of the Cross.

Jesus' promise to St. Faustina

"Say unceasingly this chaplet that I have taught you. Anyone who says it will receive great Mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as the last hope. Even the most hardened sinner, if he recites this Chaplet even once, will receive grace from My Infinite Mercy. I want to give unimaginable graces to those who trust in My Mercy..."

"...When they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person not as the just judge but as the Merciful Savior..."
