# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings on this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! As Christians, we believe in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. These three divine persons are a single communion of infinite, eternal love. Let us ponder deeply this central mystery of our faith and give thanks to God for His trinitarian presence in our Church.

Our country celebrates Memorial Day this weekend, the unofficial start of the summer. As Catholics, we pray for the men and women who have given their lives in service to their county. May God grant them eternal rest, and may their sacrifices be dutifully honored by a grateful nation.

Please remember to keep up your holy habits throughout the summer: Mass, prayer, service, reading Scripture, Confession, etc. While we take time to relax during these hot summer months, let us not become lukewarm in the practice of our Catholic faith. I imagine the slower summer schedule will allow some parishioners to dedicate more energy to their relationship with Christ. If you have extra time, consider spending a moment in one of our Adoration chapels or participate in Mass during the week.

Perhaps you could come to Mass on the Feast of Saint Joan of Arc. The Catholic Church celebrates our patroness on May 30 each year. Therefore, we will have a special Mass at the Saint Joan of Arc campus at 7:00 p.m. this Thursday. (This means we will cancel the regular 6:30 p.m. Thursday Mass at Saint Peter.) May God bless our community as we commemorate this bold, heroic maiden from France. And may we always follow her example of unwavering faith.

The good news is that we will have Deacon Elchert with us until Labor Day, so there will be time to bid him farewell over the summer.
