FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

A blessed Feast of the Corpus Christi! This weekend, we recall the significance of the Blessed Sacrament. Jesus has gifted us with His Body and Blood which allows us to experience incredible intimacy with our God. Jesus fulfills His promise to us: "I am with you always, even until the end of the age." As Catholics, we give thanks for the real presence of Jesus in the Church and in our lives.

Perhaps you did not know that Swahili-speaking families in Columbus have celebrated a monthly Mass at Saint Peter Church for the past several years. This joy-filled community has practiced their Catholic faith and preserved their traditions in our midst. Now, this group of East Africans has decided to move across town to Saint Elizabeth on Sharon Woods Boulevard. That church is able to offer an earlier Mass time on Sunday afternoons, and the location is more convenient for that community, too. We wish our Swahili-speaking brothers and sisters well as they celebrate their final Mass at Saint Peter this weekend, and we give thanks to God for the ways they have blessed us.

Looking ahead, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, the first Friday of June. This is a quintessential Catholic devotion. We contemplate the love of the Savior's heart which was pierced by the soldier's lance and became a font of mercy for the entire human race. In our prayer, we surrender ourselves completely to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. And through the sacraments of the Church, we place ourselves at the foot of the cross, allowing the blood and water which flows from that divine heart to cleanse and strengthen us.
