## ST. TERESA'S OUTREACH – WE ARE COMMITTED TO SERVING THE POOR

### WEEKLY FOOD PANTRY COLLECTION

Two full carloads of food from St. Peter were sent to St. John and Help My Neighbor food pantries in both April and May.
